ORDINANCE NO. 201

AN ORDINANCE OF NEW SEWICKLEY TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA VACATING MELONY PLACE, A ROAD IN THE BARTON PLAN OF LOTS, WITH THE RESULT THAT MELONY PLACE WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED FOR PUBLIC USE BY THE TOWNSHIP AS PREVIOUSLY DECLARED IN RESOLUTION 7 OF 1986.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by New Sewickley Township, Beaver County, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the Township of New Sewickley passed Resolution 7 in 1986, accepting for public use several streets in the Barton Park plan of lots, including Melony Place.
- 2. The Second Class Township code, 53 PS. Section 67305, permits a Township, after a public hearing on the matter, to vacate a road, thereby repealing any previous acceptance of the road for public use.
- 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby vacates Melony Place in the Barton Park plan of lots and repeals that section of Resolution 7 of 1986 where the Township had previously accepted Melony Place for public use. Resolution 7 of 1986 remains in full force and effect as to the other listed roads.
