

ORDINANCE NO. 201

AN ORDINANCE OF NEW SEWICKLEY TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA VACATING MELONY PLACE, A ROAD IN THE BARTON PLAN OF LOTS, WITH THE RESULT THAT MELONY PLACE WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED FOR PUBLIC USE BY THE TOWNSHIP AS PREVIOUSLY DECLARED IN RESOLUTION 7 OF 1986.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by New Sewickley Township, Beaver County, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of the Township of New Sewickley passed Resolution 7 in 1986, accepting for public use several streets in the Barton Park plan of lots, including Melony Place.

2. The Second Class Township code, 53 PS. Section 67305, permits a Township, after a public hearing on the matter, to vacate a road, thereby repealing any previous acceptance of the road for public use.


3. The Board of Supervisors hereby vacates Melony Place in the Barton Park plan of lots and repeals that section of Resolution 7 of 1986 where the Township had previously accepted Melony Place for public use. Resolution 7 of 1986 remains in full force and effect as to the other listed roads.
