ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE OF NEW SEWICKLEY TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OR DUMPING OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NEW SEWICKLEY AND THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC OR PRIVATE DUMPS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE SAID TOWNSHIP AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION" BY INCREASING THE FINE AND PENALTY PROVIDED FOR IN SAID ORDINANCE FROM \$25.00 AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION TO \$300.00 AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of New Sewickley Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of Ordinance No. 4, of New Sewickley Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, shall upon summary conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300.00 and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to be imprisoned in the Beaver County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days provided that each day's continuance of the violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 2. ALL Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.
