Dear Beaver County Farm Operator,

The Beaver County Conservation District provides a range of services to support farm operations in the county. The District provides technical assistance to reduce erosion and improve water quality on agricultural lands. The District supports improved farm economics by assisting farmers with the development of prescribed grazing systems, soil testing programs and other best management practices. The District can provide information on funding and cost share opportunities to implement a range of best management practices on farms.

The Conservation District can help farmers develop the written plans necessary to meet state manure and nutrient management as well as agricultural erosion and sedimentation requirements. All farm operations that till more than 5,000 square feet (including no-till) are required to have an erosion and sedimentation control plan. All farming operations that land apply manure must develop and implement a written manure management plan.

The District rents a Great Plains no-till drill and a Stoltzfus lime spreader to farm operators to support conservation tillage and fertility management on agricultural fields.

Providing support to farm operations in the county is a key function of the Conservation District. Please contact us. District staff are happy to meet with you on the farm to discuss your concerns and provide support as you improve your farm operation.
